## Pro Tips for Preferencing

- You MUST have two adult mentors pass the YPP program BEFORE you will be allowed to register for your first event.
- Do this NOW!
- DO NOT change mentors between your first and second registration or they may not get through the YPP process.
- If you need to change mentors, wait until after you register for your 2<sup>nd</sup> event.

#### **Event Registration**

- Starting September 21, you will have one week to enter your ranked event preferences for your first event
  - Assignments are done by lottery
  - It gives you no advantage to enter your event preferences early. Relax! All entries before 9 am 9-28-22 will have the same chance.
- If you select your home event, you will be given that preference (no need to select any additional events)
- If you select an event other than your home event, you will be subject to the outcome of the lottery.
- Remember, you are only guaranteed your home event during your first registration window. If you don't choose it at that time, it opens up to anyone else who did and there may not be room in that event come second registration.

#### Event Registration continued...

- If you pick an event other than your home event, there is a VERY good chance you will initially end up on the waitlist initially (on Friday, Sept 29).
- FIRST Staff will work to move everyone off the waitlist by the end of the day on Monday.
- I will reach out to teams still on the waitlist after FIRST HQ has made all of their adjustments
- Please do not reach out to me before Tuesday morning (Oct 3) if you end up
  on a wait list. I will be working with FIRST to get everyone moved off and will
  not respond to emails asking about waitlist status until after that is finished



#### Status of the FRC District

- We expect to have 125 teams this year (hopefully more!)
  - We have 7 confirmed rookies and 1 potential rookie
  - We have 2 PNW teams that may be splitting and forming a second team
- We are holding 8 district events
- District Championship will be at Veterans Memorial Center in Portland, OR April  $3^{rd} 6^{th}$ , 2024
  - See, I told you we would be back at Veterans Memorial ;-)

## About Third Plays



- Third plays cost \$1,000 and do not count for points
  - You can still win awards at third plays, but no points
  - Their may not be many 3<sup>rd</sup> play options this year
  - Registration opens 10-26-23
- You have the option of doing a third play in another district
  - Registration opens 11-7-23
  - These are assigned last after all inner district plays have been assigned
  - Inter-district plays do not qualify for any awards or points
  - Inter-district play does not affect the chronological order of your events
- You have the option of doing a third play at a Regional Event
  - Registration opens 10-26-23
    - You will pay the full cost of an additional Regional (\$4000)
    - Regional play does not qualify for points
    - You can receive SOME awards at a Regional
    - You may not qualify for Championships in Houston from a Regional Event \*\*New last year
- Teams will receive a separate invoice for third play, regional, and inter-district play from *FIRST* Washington.

## PNW District participation fees



- The participation fee this year is \$13,000
  - DON'T PANIC! Breathe.... Ahhhh.....
- FIRST Washington and ORTOP are fundraising on your behalf right now! We have raised much of the difference already
- There is a grant system in place for ALL PNW district teams
  - You **MUST** fill out the *PNW* Registration form and check the box that you would like to be considered for a grant.
  - You MUST fill out the registration form by September 30 (yes that is next week) to be considered for a grant



## Following Donor Intent

- We work very hard in raising unrestricted funds so we can allocate to teams in need.
- However, many donors do request that their donations are allocated to specific circumstances.
- Team invoices will be different due to honoring donor intent

#### What has changed and Why?

#### WHY?

These Changes should make the grant submission and fund allocation process run more smoothly and quickly!

#### MANAGEMENT

FIRST Washington is now the administrator of the OSPI grant funds

FIRST Washington will be managing the application process

> \*The application is very different from the one in the iGrant system

#### **FUNDING**

- The grant will no longer be a reimbursable grant
- You will receive the funds from us once you have received your grant award and have entered your registered teams
- If you run multiple teams, you may receive some additional funding

#### REPORTING

 You will need to submit a year-end report

\*Details on this report will be sent out at a later date. We expect the report to open in Jan 2024 and close the end of May 2024

This report MUST be filled out to be eligible to receive funds next year

#### What is the process?



Grant forms will be on the OSPI page on <a href="https://firstwa.org/ospi/">https://firstwa.org/ospi/</a>

One form per building per program will be accepted

Register your team(s) with FIRST Washington

In early October the main contact for the grant will be notified if you have received an award and will be asked to log in and fill out 2 forms with additional information. Please watch for this email, you will have 7 days to fill out this form.

Once the forms are filled out, you will be notified of the grant amount you have received, and *FIRST* Washington will mail a check to your school/district

Remember, if you fill out the grant as a coach, it is your responsibility to know District Requirements and where the check goes

#### Who should fill out the grant?

Coaches need to talk with the school district and follow their district policy on who should fill out the grant

 For our purposes, it could be either the coach or an admin at the school

If you are the coach of a school district team, it is your responsibility to check with your school and know who at your district will apply for this grant
