FTC participation fees

- The participation fee this year is \$925
 - DON'T PANIC! Breathe.... Ahhhh.....
- *FIRST* Washington is fundraising on your behalf right now! We have raised most of the difference already
- There is a grant system in place for FTC teams
 - You MUST fill out the FIRST Washington Registration form and check the box that you would like to be considered for a grant.
 - To be considered for a grant, you must fill out the FIRST Washington registration by September 30



Funding & Grant opportunities

- OSPI Grant (for Washington Public and Tribal Compact schools): Grant is open NOW and will close Sept 29. If you want more info on this grant, we will be talking about it in more detail at the end of this presentation
- FIRST Washington Grant: Grant is open now and will close Sept 30. When you register your FTC team, you can select if you would like access to grant funds to lower your registration fees

WHY?

These Changes should make the grant submission and fund allocation process run more smoothly and quickly!

MANAGEMENT

FIRST Washington is now the administrator of the OSPI grant funds

FIRST Washington will be managing the application process

*The application is very different from the one in the iGrant system

FUNDING

- The grant will no longer be a reimbursable grant
- You will receive the funds from us once you have received your grant award and have entered your registered teams
- If you run multiple teams, you may receive some additional funding

REPORTING

You will need to submit a year-end report

> *Details on this report will be sent out at a later date. We expect the report to open in Jan 2024 and close the end of May 2024

This report MUST be filled out to be eligible to receive funds next year

What is the process?

Grant forms will be on the OSPI page on <u>https://firstwa.org/ospi/</u>

One form per building per program will be accepted Register your team(s) with *FIRST* Washington

In early October the main contact for the grant will be notified if you have received an award and will be asked to fill out a form with additional information. **Please watch for this email, you will have 7 days to fill out this form.** Jualcoww

Once the form is filled out, you will be notified of the grant amount you have received, and *FIRST* Washington will mail a check to your school/district
