How Ranking works for Interleagues

- After the second league event, teams have played up to 12 matches
- A Team's ranking at the start of the interleague event is based on their best 10 matches from their league events
- At the interleague event, teams will play 5 more matches, of which the all 5 are added to the 10 best matches from the league events
- Those 15 matches form the rankings going into alliance selection

Dean's List

- Nominations are due by Dec 15
- Interviews will be done remotely and will be scheduled for Jan 9-20
- Coaches will be emailed to schedule an interview after the first of the year
- Finalists will be announced at State

Judging Interviews

- Interleague will be your first judged event of the year
- Team interviews will happen in the morning. Each team should bring to the interview
 - Engineering Portfolio
 - Control Award Submission
 - Team Feedback Request form (optional)
- During the day, judges may attempt to interview teams in the pit area
- Judging details in Game Manual Part 1, section 9
