Overview

FIRST Washington invites all FTC and FRC teams to participate in the Al Innovation Video Challenge, a new initiative designed to highlight how teams explored, experimented with, or meaningfully used Al during their season.

Teams will create a short video (15–60 seconds, 30 seconds recommended) showcasing an innovative example of how AI supported your team's work—engineering, coding, outreach, strategy, design, documentation, or anything else your team discovered.

Videos may be created using traditional editing tools or with Al-assisted tools. Al use is allowed but not required for the video creation itself. However, the video must clearly communicate how your team used Al at some point during the season.

The top submitted videos will be featured on the *FIRST* Washington website, at FRC district events, on social media, and in the quarterly newsletter.

Video Requirements

- Length: 15-60 seconds (30 seconds recommended)
- Format: Horizontal or vertical (vertical 9: 16 preferred)
- Content: Must explain or demonstrate one or more ways your team used Al during the season
- Tools: Any editing style or platform allowed (Al-generated content optional)
- Originality: Your team must produce or significantly transform the content

In your email, please include short responses to the following questions:

- 1. What AI tool(s) did your team use during the season?
- 2. How did Al support or enhance your work?
- 3. If AI was used to help make the video, what tools did you use and why?
- 4. What lessons did your team learn about Al during the process?
- 5. What advice would you give another team exploring Al for the first time?

Judging Criteria

Videos will be evaluated by FIRST Washington staff and volunteers based on the following criteria:

Most Creative Use of Al During the Season

Displays innovative or unexpected applications of Al in robotics, outreach, strategy, or team operations.

Video Look & Design

Clear storytelling, strong visuals, thoughtful editing, and engaging presentation.

Highlighting FIRST Values

Demonstrates Gracious Professionalism, Coopertition, teamwork, learning, and community impact.

Clarity of Explanation

The video clearly communicates what the team did, how AI was used, and why it mattered.

Real-World Impact or Insight

Shows meaningful improvement, efficiency, creativity, or learning as a result of using Al.

Recognition

Top submissions will be showcased:

- On the FIRST Washington website
- At FRC district events on the big screens
- On FIRST Washington social media channels
- In the FIRST WA quarterly newsletter
